PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The board met in July via Zoom as Covid cases continue to impact our comfort of conducting in-person meetings. We will hold the August 1 meeting via Zoom as well.

Owners will be receiving Board Directors election ballots from Anderson & Co. The election results will be read during the October board meeting.

We have received a project plan from our contractor for the painting project in section B. We will now work with other construction, and painting contractors to obtain competitive bids on the required prepainting repair work as well as the painting and staining portions of the job.

As some have noticed, the surface of our tennis courts is in need of repair. The board is currently getting bids for the that work. We will be looking at various options including the possible conversion of some of the space to a dedicated pickle ball court. We will seek feedback from our community once our possible options and costs are understood.

The board has updated the clubhouse rules in an effort to consolidate all of the rules into a single document. The proposed set of updated rules is being distributed by Anderson to all owners for comment. The clubhouse is currently available for private events, and those may be scheduled through Anderson.

FOOD New Restaurant in Rio del Mar by Karen McCarty (436 Oyster Drive)

Last month, several of us dined at the new Venus Cocktails & Kitchen Beachside in Rio del Mar, which opened on June 22. It is located on the site of the former Cafe Rio. It is the second restaurant opened by Venus Spirits; the first location is in Santa Cruz. (Venus Spirits also has a tasting room that adjoins its Santa Cruz restaurant and its distillary.)

Even though it was only their second night of being open, the food was delicious, and the service was very attentive! We ordered hush puppies, fries, lobster rolls (stuffed full into incredible rolls and served with a yummy parsley fennel salad), and key lime pie. I would highly recommend all of these dishes.

At this time, they have a limited menu, pricing is very reasonable and reservations are a must! Check out my photos from tonight's meal. You will note the key lime pie was half eaten by the time I snapped a photo!


