# **Social Network for Neighbors**



# **Share the Road and Stay Safe**

We live adjacent to a major bike route. And, bicycle safety is a serious matter. If you're not a cyclist,



you likely have been annoyed by a cyclist who doesn't obey the laws or was just plain rude. If you are a cyclist, you have probably been upset by a driver who did something that threatened your safety.

A 2014 California law requires each of us to give a cyclist three feet of space between car and rider. However, you should not break any other driving laws in order to provide this separation. An article with details can be found at:

There are many arguments that giving three feet is not the answer to safety for cyclists, and that providing more bike lanes is the real answer. But we're stuck with what we have and have to make the best of it.

been a rule follower, so I pretty much follow the rules of the road. I appreciate considerate drivers and respond with a wave of thanks. I wear a side-view mirror so to watch for cars, make eye contact with drivers, and try to share the

So, share the road. There are plenty of poor drivers and cyclists out there, but we've got to share the road with them all and live to tell about it.
